Borough of Ship Bottom Special Meeting Minutes May 15, 2013

The following are the minutes of the special meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Ship Bottom, which was held on Wednesday, May 15, 2013, in the Council Room located at 1621 Long Beach Blvd., Ship Bottom, NJ 08008.

Mayor Huelsenbeck called the meeting to order at 4:40 p.m. and asked the Clerk to take attendance. The following were present:

Councilmen Tallon, English, Sinopoli, Rossi and Hartman. Gleason, absent.

Mayor Huelsenbeck asked the Clerk to read the Statement of Notice. It is as follows:

This Special Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Ship Bottom being held on May 15, 2013, at 4:30 p.m., was called pursuant to the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act. Notice was sent to the Atlantic City Press, the Asbury Park Press and the Beach Haven Times on May 13, 2013 and also posted on the bulletin board in the Municipal Building on May 13, 2013.

The Mayor called for the approval of the minutes of the meeting held on March 26, 2013. On a motion by Councilman English, seconded by Councilman Rossi, the minutes were approved.

WHEREAS, Teamsters Local No. 35 is the recognized majority representative for certain Borough employees in two (2) bargaining units: Public Works and Office Professionals; and

WHEREAS, the agreements between the Borough and Public Works and between the Borough and Office Professionals both expired on December 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Borough and Teamsters Local No. 35 have agreed to terms for successor collective negotiations agreements between them on behalf of the two (2) aforementioned bargaining units: and

WHEREAS, the bargaining units have ratified the memorandum of agreement; and WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to approve the memorandum of agreement and the collective negotiations agreements in substantially the form attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. The Borough approves the attached memorandum of agreement between the Borough and Teamsters Local No. 35 for a successor collective negotiations agreement between them for the Public Works and Office Professionals bargaining units; and
- 2. The Borough approves the collective negotiations agreements between it and the Public Works Unit and the Office Professionals Unit in substantially the same form as is attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has presented these changes to Teamsters Local No. 35 for consideration and comment; and

WHEREAS, Teamsters Local No. 35 have expressed their agreement with the changes to the drug and alcohol policy.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Borough hereby approves and adopts the attached Zero Tolerance Drug and Alcohol Policy and incorporates same into the Employee Manual; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Labor Counsel is directed to incorporate this policy into the Employee Handbook; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Administrator shall notify all employees of the new policy.

WHEREAS, the applicant is qualified to be licensed according to all standards established by Title 33 of the New Jersey Statutes, and the regulations promulgated thereunder, as well as pertinent local ordinances and conditions consistent with Title 33; and

WHEREAS, the applicant has disclosed and the Ship Bottom Police Department has reviewed the source of all funds used in the purchase of the license, as well as the licensed business and all additional financing obtained in connection with the licensed business; and

WHEREAS, the application for a person to person transfer has been submitted in accordance with requirements of the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control, and the applicant had been reviewed and approved by the municipal Police Department.

The Mayor, Council and Rich Bethea discussed placing houses in the street for a limited time, in order to get them raised. It was decided that we would put a policy in place regarding this.

There was also discussion regarding the replenishment of the Surf City and Brant Beach beaches and whether we could honor their badges within a few blocks of our border.

The Clerk reminded the Mayor and Council that the Beach Opening at the 17th St. beach, sponsored by the Chamber of Commerce will be happening on Saturday, May 18th.

On a motion by Councilman Rossi, seconded by Councilman Sinopoli, and an all in favor vote, all aye, Mayor Huelsenbeck adjourned the meeting at 5:12 p.m..
