# RESOLUTION 2017-150 RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF SHIP BOTTOM, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE TREASURER TO REFUND MONEY ON A TAX SALE CERTIFICATE

## RESOLUTION 2017-151 RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF SHIP BOTTOM, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE OF COMPENSATION FOR THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council are requesting an increase in compensation of \$1,000,00 each

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Ship Bottom, County of Ocean, that an increase in compensation to the Mayor and Councilman of \$1,000.00 each is approved. The Mayor's compensation will be \$7,000.00 and the Councilman's compensation will be \$6,000.00 each. This resolution is retroactive to January 1, 2017.

Mayor Huelsenbeck called for Ordinance 2017-09: Second reading, public hearing and adoption: Construction Code, Uniform, fees. On a motion by Councilman Rossi, seconded by Councilman Tallon, all in favor, all aye, Mayor Huelsenbeck opened the hearing to the public.

Seeing no response from the public, on a motion by Councilman Rossi, seconded by Councilman Tallon, all in favor, all aye, Mayor Huelsenbeck closed the hearing to the public.

On a motion by Councilman Rossi, seconded by Councilman Butkus, Ordinance 2017-09 was adopted as follows:

### **ORDINANCE 2017-09**

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SHIP BOTTOM, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 15.18 OF TITLE 15 OF THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF SHIP BOTTOM ENTITLED "CONSTRUCTION CODES, UNIFORM" SO AS TO PROVIDE A FEE SCHEDULE FOR MECHANICAL SUB-CODE APPLICATION AS REQUIRED BY THE UNIFORM CONSTRUCTION CODE REGULATIONS

**BE IT ORDAINED,** by the governing body of the Borough of Ship Bottom, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Section 15.18.080 of Chapter 15.18 of the Borough Code of the Borough of Ship Bottom entitled "Fees applicable to sections 15.18.040 through 15.18.070" is hereby amended and supplemented to add new Paragraph E which shall read as follows:

- E. Mechanical Sub-code Fees.
  - 1. R-3 and R-5 use groups (excluding new construction).
  - a. First device.................\$60.00

**SECTION 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid of unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect after public reading and publication as required by law.

Roll Call: Tallon, Valyo, Butkus and Rossi, all aye.

Mayor Huelsenbeck called for the request from Southern Regional High School for Senior Service Day to be held on May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018 on our ocean beaches. On a motion by Councilman Rossi, seconded by Councilman Tallon, this request was approved.

Mayor Huelsenbeck called for the request from Cheryl Kirby of Things A Drift, on behalf of the Ship Bottom Merchants Association, requesting outdoor tents and artist setups on November 24 & 25 and also December 1, 2 & 3. They would be able to take advantage of Small Business Weekend and the Christmas Parade Weekend. On a motion by Councilman Valyo, seconded by Councilman Butkus, this was approved.

Mayor Huelsenbeck called for the request from Janet Dwyer and Angela Goheen to hold their marriage ceremony on the 16<sup>th</sup> St. beach on November 25, 2017 at 12:00 p.m. On a motion by Councilman Butkus, seconded by Councilman Valyo, this was approved.

Total taxes collected was \$2,597,164.88. Delinquent tax notices were mailed out on Monday, 11-27-17. Ship Bottom currently has 210 properties that are delinquent with the real estate taxes. During the past month, 3 properties that were sold during a tax sale for delinquent taxes and/or water/sewer have been redeemed and are in good standing.

### Public Safety: Councilman Tom Tallon

There were 616 reported activities. There were 3,021 patrol vehicle miles. There were 248 beach, building and business checks. There were also 187 traffic stops, 2 motor vehicle accidents with injuries, 9 motor vehicle accidents without injuries and one DUI.

### Parks and Recreation:

Councilman Edward English Given by Mayor Huelsenbeck

The 38<sup>th</sup> Annual Christmas Parade is on Saturday from 1:00 to 3:00 along Long Beach Blvd. Our theme is "Deck the Hulls'. Please join us. Holiday beach badges will be sold at the parade and at Borough Hall until we are sold out.

### Public Property & Community Affairs: Councilman Joseph Valyo

Code Enforcement: There were 16 verbal warnings issued for the following: 1 unleashed dogs, 4 illegal signs, 6 trash, 2 trailers on street, 1 overgrown grass and 2 construction materials on street. There was 1 summons for constriction materials on street.

Zoning: 20 zoning permits and 12 resale inspections.

Construction: 37 permits and 4 permit updates, for a total of 41 permits processed. The type of work was: 24 alteration/renovations, 6 addition/rehabs, 8 new buildings, 1 addition and 2 demolitions. The total revenue was \$32,341.00.

### Water/Sewer: Counci

Councilman Robert Butkus

From October 24trh to November 27<sup>th</sup>, we collected \$48,893.93 in water payments, \$55,977.24 in sewer payments, for a total of \$104,871.17.

Currently 64 accounts are in delinquent status and will be scheduled for turn-off (disconnects) on December 1, 2017. 3 properties have been cut and capped due to demolition.

We met with Ocean County Utilities Authority regarding the billing for our water. It was decided we would leave the billing as is for now.

P&A Construction will give a 1week notice to the property owners that will be affected by the ongoing water/sewer main replacement project.

## Public Works: Councilman Peter Rossi

- 1. Maintenance and repairs done on all borough vehicles and equipment.
- 2. Metal, TV and brush picked up.

- 3. Ocean and Bay Beach entrances shoveled and swept. All handicapped entrances cleared several times as needed. Ocean beach entrances back blade. Tire tracks found on 5th St. dune filled and rolled.
- 4. Grass cutting and weeding and spraying throughout the borough.
- 5. Cardboard loaded into dumpster at 3rd. St. yard.
- 6. Restrooms closed at bay beach. Winterized, power washed and painted. Trash cans picked up.
- 7. Repaired broken pipe (frozen) and closed restrooms at the boat ramp. (closed)
- 8. Borough hall set up for election day. Set back up after election day.
- 9. Removed all green benches from ocean beaches.
- 10. Sprinkler systems winterized and shut off for season.
- 11. Winterized life guard house.
- 12. Fire extinguishers inspected throughout the borough, also lift inspected.
- 13. Continued working on snow fence on ocean beach. Replacing broken post and railings.
- 14. Repaired bulkhead washout on 25th and 26th pavilion area. Several holes filled at boat ramp.
- 15. Worked on memory benches and banners for Christmas Parade.
- 16. Christmas decorations put throughout the borough. (several man hrs.)

On a motion by Councilman Rossi, seconded by Councilman Butkus, Mayor Huelsenbeck opened the meeting to the public.

Seeing no response from the audience, on a motion by Councilman Butkus, seconded by Councilman Tallon, Mayor Huelsenbeck closed the meeting to the public.

On a motion by Councilman Rossi, seconded by Councilman Tallon, Mayor Huelsenbeck adjourned the meeting at 7:25 pm.
