Special Meeting Minutes  
January 15, 2015

The following are the minutes of the Special Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Ship Bottom, which was held on Thursday, January 15, 2015, in the Borough Hall Council Chambers, located at 1621 Long Beach Boulevard, Ship Bottom, New Jersey.

Mayor Huelsenbeck called the Special Meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Mayor Huelsenbeck asked the Deputy Clerk to take attendance. The following were present:

Councilmen English, Gleason, Hartman, Tallon, Sinopoli and Rossi.

Mayor Huelsenbeck asked the Deputy Clerk to read the Statement of Notice. It is as follows:

The time, date and location of this special meeting was advertised in the Asbury Park Press on January 13, 2015 and sent to the Beach Haven Times and the Atlantic City Press by e-mail on January 9, 2015, in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act. This notice was also posted in the Municipal Building on January 9, 2015.

Mayor Huelsenbeck called for the Public hearing regarding possible CDBG (Community Development Block Grant) projects.

On a motion by Councilman English, seconded by Councilman Rossi and an all in favor vote, all aye, the hearing was opened to the public. Seeing no public present, on a motion by Councilman Sinopoli, seconded by Councilman Tallon and an all in favor vote, all aye, the hearing was closed to the public.

There was discussion regarding existing handicap accessible areas in the borough. There was also discussion regarding possible projects.

1. 4<sup>th</sup> Street Park: there is handicap parking with shells in the walkways. A project would be to make it handicap accessible with brick pavers in the walkways.
2. 5<sup>th</sup> Street: make a walkway to the bay and add a rail fence to our property on the lagoon.

On a motion by Councilman Rossi, seconded by Councilman Sinopoli and an all in favor vote, all aye, Mayor Huelsenbeck adjourned the meeting at 9:15 a.m.
