# **Coastal Permitting Program Jurisdiction**

## CAFRA (N.J.S.A. 13:19-1 et seq.)

## The following activities are regulated within the CAFRA area:

- 1. Any construction on a beach or dune.
- 2. Any construction activity proposed within 150 feet of the Mean High Water Line (MHWL) or within 150 feet of a beach or dune so long as there is no intervening development.
- 3. Construction of 3 or more residential units or construction involving 5 or more parking spaces within 150 feet of MHWL, beach or dune if there is intervening development.
- 4. Construction of 25 or more residential units or construction including 50 or more parking spaces if located more than 150 feet from MHWL, beach or dune.
- 5. Any industrial development.
- 6. Public development resulting in the extension of public infrastructure (water, sewer, gas, petroleum, roads) by 1,200 feet or more, including the paving of public roads.

### Waterfront Development (N.J.S.A. 12:5-3)

### The following activities are regulated under the Waterfront Development Statute:

- 1. Any activity taking place, in a TIDAL WATERWAY, located at or waterward of the MHWL including, docks, dredging, bulkheads (new & replacement), placement of cables, etc. (Note: occupation of these areas also requires a Tidelands Conveyance)
- 2. Outside of the Coastal Area defined by CAFRA and the New Jersey Meadowlands District all construction activities in an upland area extending 100-500 feet inland from the MHWL of any tidal water (jurisdiction stops at the first paved public road parallel to the water way).
